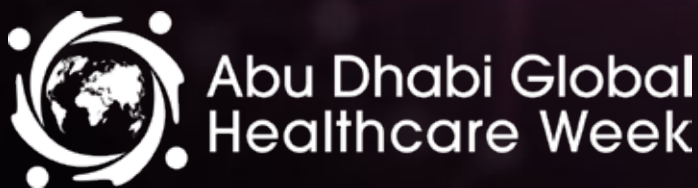

Accelerating the future of global healthcare

Abu Dhabi Global Healthcare Week 2024 was a testament to the industry's resilience and adaptability in the face of unprecedented challenges. ADGHW witnessed an array of initiative launches, exclusive previews, panel discussions, and immersive experiences, captivating audiences and stakeholders alike.

Held Under the Patronage of His Highness Sheikh Khaled bin Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi and Chairman of Abu Dhabi Executive Council, Abu Dhabi Global Healthcare Week took place 13-15 May 2024, and brought together more than 11,500 visitors, 271 speakers and 1,600 delegates from 97 countries to discuss strategies to meet future challenges in the healthcare sector and efforts to enhance health and well-being globally.

Abu Dhabi Global Healthcare Week's objectives centralised around driving impact, to accelerate the future of healthcare. Key areas included the paradigm shift from healthcare to health, public-private partnerships, ethics and standards in healthcare and life sciences, global health equity and sustainability, and the role of technology, Artificial Intelligence (AI) and innovation in the healthcare sector.

Across three days, Abu Dhabi Global Healthcare Week attracted key attendees, including Health Ministers from Egypt, the Philippines, Greece and Armenia, alongside the UAE federal ministers, members of the Abu Dhabi Executive Council, heads of local, regional and international government departments and authorities, international foundations and associations, and CEOs and business leadership.

VIP Exhibition Tour: During a tour of the exhibition, His Highness was briefed on the latest innovations in healthcare technologies and developments in medical sciences being showcased by healthcare institutions and companies. His Highness highlighted that the UAE's efforts in the healthcare sector, including launching several initiatives, innovative projects and programmes, reflect the leadership's vision to provide advanced healthcare by accelerating research in medical and therapeutic fields, and by investing in strengthening healthcare infrastructure, including hospitals, healthcare facilities and specialised laboratories to help further enhance the community's health and quality of life.









Opening ceremony

Abu Dhabi Global Healthcare Week 2024 initiated profound implications for the global healthcare ecosystem; as a barometer for market dynamics, informing strategic decisions and shaping future initiatives. Opening dialogue under the flagship edition theme 'Accelerating the future of global healthcare', His Excellency Mansoor Al Mansoori, Chairman of the Department of Health Abu Dhabi (DoH) opened dialogue on global collaboration: "When it comes to human lives and health, our world cannot operate in silos - borderless collaboration and access to digital tools in healthcare are global responsibilities that benefit humanity".

Addressing an international audience of more than 200 VIPs, including ministers and public officials, CEOs, international investors, heads of multilateral organisations, and leading health and medicine experts, the opening panel set the tone for ADGHW 2024 around 'Reimagining Health and Life: Partnering to Invest in Humanity', exploring collaborative approaches to invest in initiatives that enhance both health and overall quality of life.

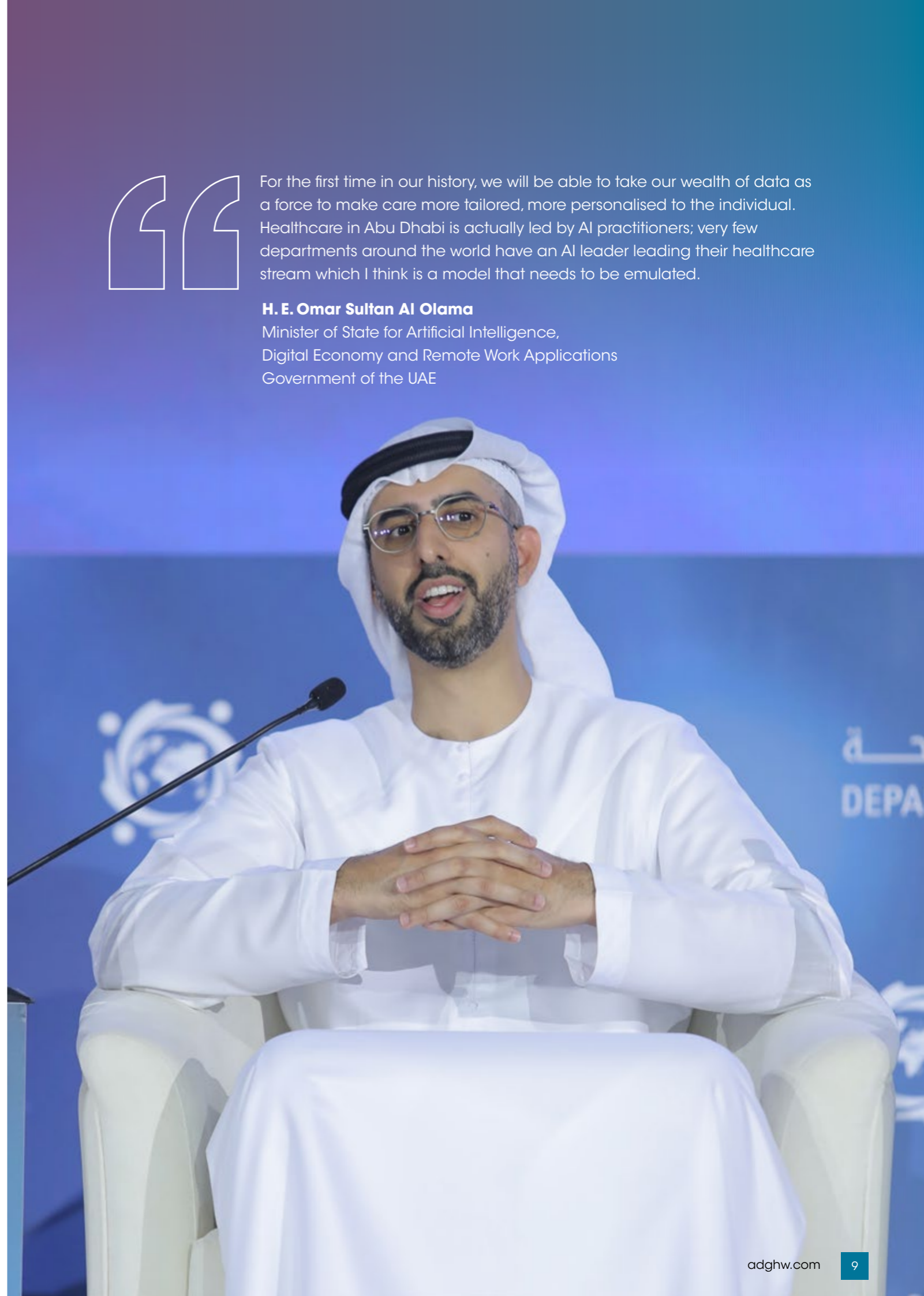



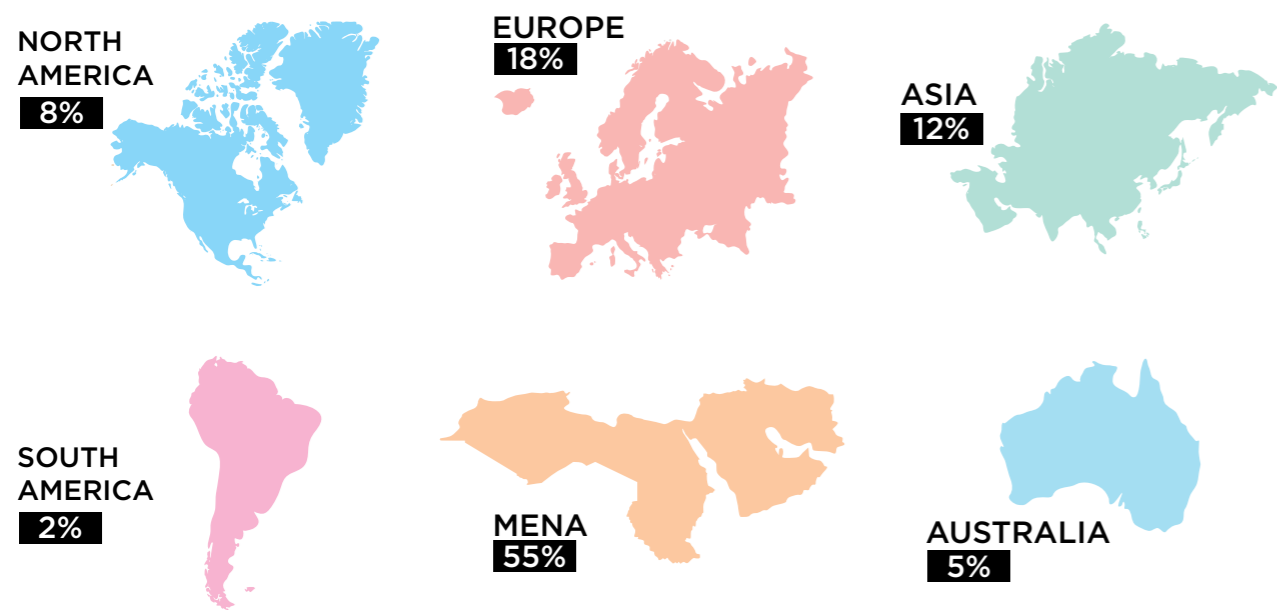


Visitor overview

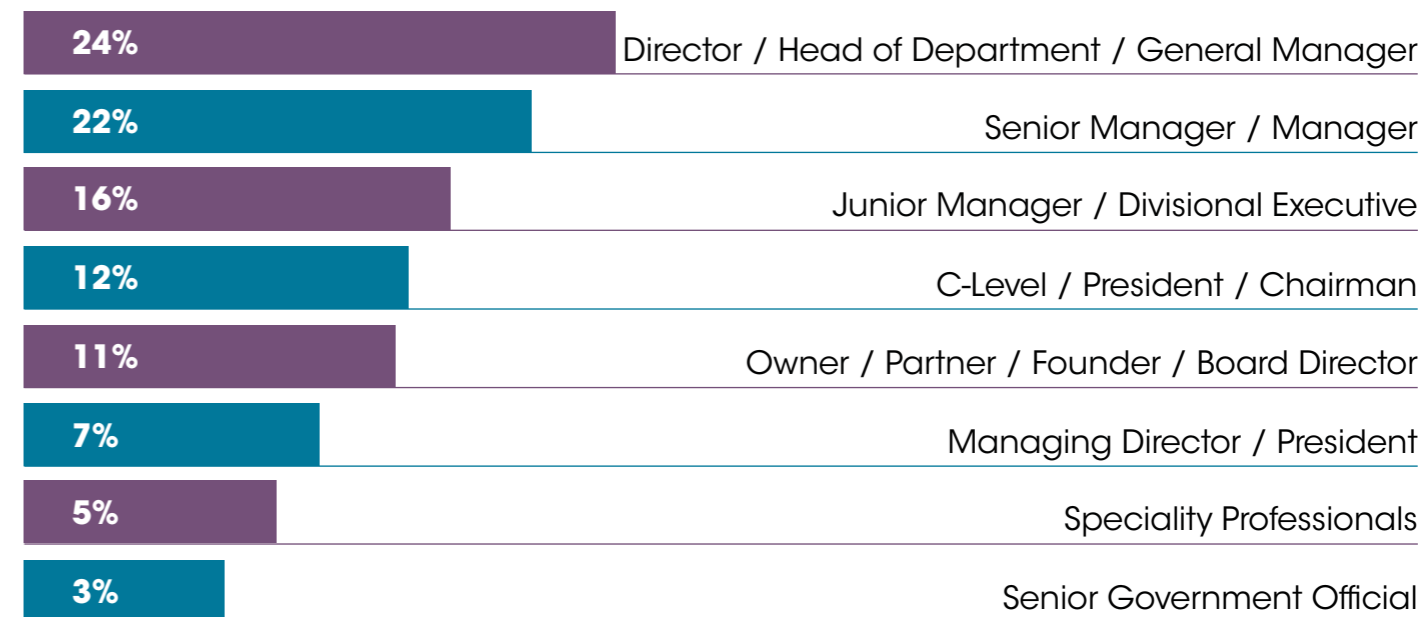
Visitors by region

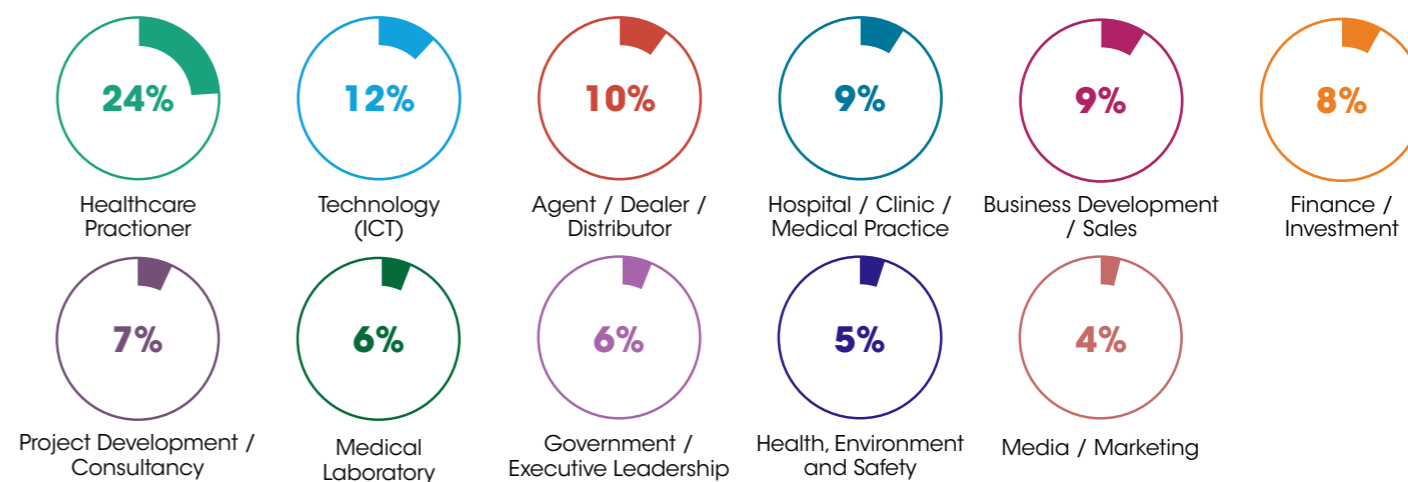


Visitors by seniority

Announcements of key outcomes including:

- Launch of the Global AI Healthcare Academy in cooperation between DoH, Mohamed bin Zayed University of Artificial Intelligence (MBZUAI) and Core42 to enhance AI-trained workforce capabilities and advance diagnostic and operational efficiency.
- Partnership between the Department and Harvard Medical School International Centre for Genetic Disease (HMS-iCGD) was announced to establish a framework for collaboration to advance clinical and translational research in genomics and Artificial Intelligence (AI).
- Translating DoH's continuous efforts to spearhead borderless collaboration, research and innovation, the Department forged a collaborative agreement with the Authority of Social Contribution - Ma'an to bolster scientific research through creating solutions that address arising healthcare challenges, as well as enhancing scientific research and innovation in the Emirate.
- The Department of Health and Awqaf Abu Dhabi also saw the launch of the AED One Billion Healthcare Endowment Fund over five years to further advance endowment work towards specialised healthcare needs of the community.
- Witnessed the launch of HealthX, a startup programme that seeks to advance Abu Dhabi as a hub in the biotech and life science industry, which will advance 30 global cutting-edge life science startups into the UAE's healthcare ecosystem over a period of two years.
